EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 26 Series of 2020

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE FRAMEWORK FOR THE RECOVERY & REHABILITATION PLAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAUANG, LA UNION DUBBED AS "ONE BAUANG: WE HEAL AS ONE."

WHEREAS, Proclamation 922 placed the entire country under National Health Emergency due to COVID-19 and enjoined all government agencies and local government units to render full assistance and cooperation, and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate responses and measures to curtail and eliminate the COVID-19 threat;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte placed the entire Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine by virtue of Proclamation 929 and ordered all local government units down to the barangays to actively and strictly impose directives from the national government;

WHEREAS, RA No. 11469 or the "Bayanihan to Heal As One Act" recognizes the serious threat of the pandemic to the health, safety, security and lives of our countrymen, and the severe disruption of economic activities;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the General Welfare Clause of the Local Government Code of 1991 gives local government units the authority to exercise powers necessary for efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MENCHIE C. LOMBOY-DE GUZMAN, M.D., Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. THE PLAN. There shall be a Recovery Plan dubbed as "ONE BAUANG: We heal as One," to respond to crisis brought by the COVID-19 pandemic and lay down forward steps for the Municipal Government of Bauang, La Union to the "new normal."

SECTION 2. PLANNING PRINCIPLES. In the preparation and implementation of such plan, the LGU shall:

- a. Act within the letter and spirit of all the rules, regulations and directives issued by the National Government pursuant to RA 11469,

- b. Implement standards of community quarantine consistent with what the national government has laid down;
- c. Continue to exercise its autonomy in matters undefined by the national government or are within the parameters it has set;
- d. Fully cooperate towards a unified, cohesive and orderly implementation of the nation policy to address COVID-19;
- e. Utilize judiciously all allowed funds to fight COVID 19 including calamity funds, reprogrammed funds as well as augmentation funds from the national government, among others.

SECTION 3. PURPOSES OF THE PLAN.

- a. Mitigate, if not to contain, the transmission and spread of COVID-19 through effective education, detection, protection and treatment.
- b. Mobilize assistance in the provision of basic necessities to families and individuals affected by the imposition of Community Quarantine, especially indigents and their families.
- c. Undertake measures that will prevent the overburdening of the healthcare system.
- d. Provide healthcare, including medical tests and treatments to COVID-19 patients, persons under investigation (PUIs), or persons under monitoring (PUMs), within LGU capacity and mandate.
- e. Undertake recovery/rehabilitation programs/projects including amelioration programs and provision of safety nets to all affected sectors
- f. Ensure that there is sufficient, adequate and readily available funding and logistics to undertake the foregoing and that unnecessary delays are avoided.
- g. Partner with private sector and other stakeholders to deliver these measures and programs quickly and efficiently.
- h. Ensure that public health workers and frontliners are protected physically, mentally and financially.
- i. Promote and protect collective interests of residents in these challenging times (i.e. fair consumer prices, credit availability, incentive packages, availability of essential goods, traffic regulations, anti-encroachments/illegal constructions, adequate supply of power & utilities, tax payment reliefs, statutory deadlines and reprieves, etc.)

SECTION 4. There is hereby organized a Technical Working Group called Cluster Groups under the IATF to provide recommendations on rebuilding confidence and adjusting to the "new normal" under five planning sectors namely: institutional, economic, social, environmental and infrastructure.

Specifically, the TWG/Cluster Groups shall strive to:

1. Reduce uncertainty by making information available to answer some of the questions of the various stakeholders
2. Recommend programs and strategies to mitigate the losses experienced by consumers, businesses, workers, sectoral groups and the community in general.
3. Recommend policies and programs to adapt to a "new normal" state of social and economic activities.

TWG Secretariat – The Municipal Planning and Development Officer and staff shall serve as the Technical Working Group or Cluster Group over-all secretariat.

Recovery Plan dubbed as "ONE Bauang: We Heal As One" and provide a weekly report to the Municipal Mayor of all acts performed pursuant to said plan and this order.

The report shall include the amount and corresponding utilization of the funds used, augmented, programmed, reallocated and realigned.

The Municipal Planning and Development Office shall act as the over-all Secretariat of the TWG or Cluster Groups. It shall also receive recovery plan reports for consolidation prior to submission to the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 4. OVERSIGHT. The IATF shall oversee the implementation of the recovery plan. It shall determine whether it is within the purview of RA 11426.

SECTION . Effectivity. This order shall take effect immediately.
