EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 055, SERIES OF 2020

REGULATING THE OPERATIONS OF ALL MUNICIPAL CEMETERIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAUANG IN THE OBSERVANCE OF ALL SAINTS' DAY AND ALL SOULS' DAY

WHEREAS, remembering our departed loved ones every 1st and 2nd day of November every year has become a tradition;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued Resolution No. 71, which in effect prevents the public from the traditional observance of All Souls and All Saints' Day due to the coronavirus pandemic.

WHEREAS, mass gatherings or flocking of people during All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day in municipal cemeteries pose dangers of spreading the Covid-19 virus;

WHEREAS, the number of visitors in all private and public cemeteries, memorial parks, and the like, shall be limited to a maximum of thirty percent (30%) of the venue capacity, with the wearing of face masks and face shields, and the observance of social distancing observed at all times.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MENCHIE C. LOMBOY DE GUZMAN, M.D, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order as follows:

Section 1. CLOSURE OF ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE CEMETERIES ON NOVEMBER 1 & 2, 2020. All cemeteries in the municipality shall be closed from November 1-2, 2020. However, visits in both public and private cemeteries except on the prohibited dates shall be allowed.

Section 2. ALTERNATIVE SCHEDULE OF CEMETERY VISITATION. Visitors in all private and public cemeteries shall be allowed five (5) days prior and after the prohibited dates following the prescribed schedule, to wit:

Section 3. ENTRY PROCEDURES. All visitors shall be guided by the following upon entry:

- a. Submit to triage at designated entries;
- b. Observe minimum health standards;
- c. Wear face shield and face mask;
- d. No entry below 21 years old and above 60 years old;
- e. ENTRY PASS:

Residents	Barangay Pass Slips
Non –residents (within the region)	Medical certificate and valid ID
Non-residents (outside the region)	Travel authority from PNP

- f. Strictly no bringing of alcohol and deadly, pointed and flammable materials.
- g. Avoid unnecessary noise inside the cemetery.
- h. Use authorized ENTRY and EXIT points only;

Section 4. COMPLIANCE. Those who refuse to follow, cooperate, or violate this ORDER shall be penalized in accordance with the provisions of Bayanihan to Recover as One Act, also known as Bayanihan 2, as well as existing laws, rules and regulations.

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event that any provision of this ORDER or any part hereof is declared unconstitutional, invalid, or illegal by a competent authority or a court of law, the provisions not thereby affected shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ORDER, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval and shall remain in force unless otherwise revoked or cancelled or until the accomplishment of the purposes of this ORDER.
